

Journey Description

By car:

From western direction:

Follow B80 in direction »Magdeburg/Klinikum Kröllwitz/Universität (Weinbergweg)« until crossing Gimritzer Damm/Blücherstraße.

Other directions (Autobahn A9, A14):

Leave the A9 at the exit Halle, the A14 at the exit »Halle-Peißen«, follow the signs to »Zentrum« and »Halle-Neustadt/Eisleben (Riebeckplatz)«, leave the street after crossing the bridge over the river Saale at the exit »Gimritzer Damm« and follow the signs to »Magdeburg/Klinikum Kröllwitz/Universität (Weinbergweg)« until crossing Gimritzer Damm/Blücherstraße.

Main building Walter-Hülse-Straße 1:

Turn left onto Blücherstraße and follow the street until the end. Then turn right onto Walter-Hülse-Straße and follow the street approx. 350 m to the Fraunhofer-Institute on the right hand side of the street.

For visitors to Heideallee 19:

Continue straight ahead at the intersection of Gimritzer Damm and Blücherstraße. The Fraunhofer Institute (Heideallee 19) is located at the end of Gimritzer Damm on the right-hand side.

By train:

By train to Halle (Saale) railway station. From the »Hauptbahnhof Halle (Saale)« stop, take tram lines 4 or 5 to Kröllwitz, get off at the »Weinberg Campus« stop (the stop before that is called »Gimritzer Damm«). Travel time around 20 minutes.

By plane:

From the airport Halle/Leipzig take the train S5/S5x (10 min) to the main station Halle (Saale) or a taxi (50 min) to Halle.
